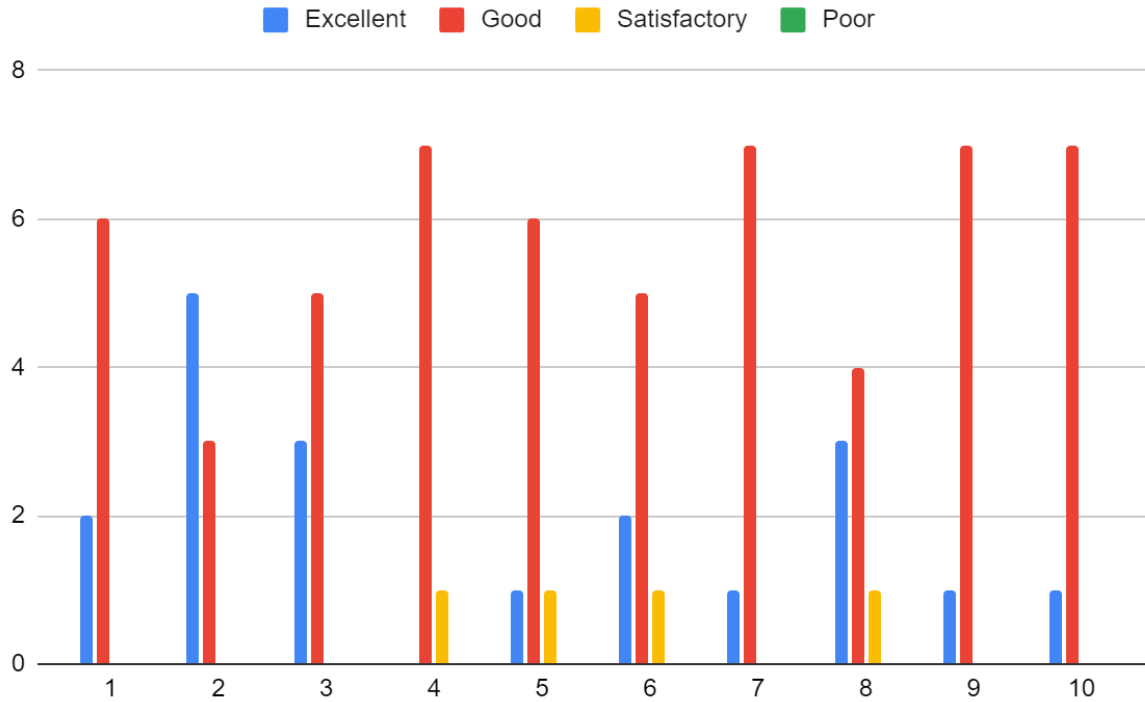

Rating Distribution:

- **Satisfactory Ratings:** Some criteria received “Satisfactory” ratings, suggesting areas where improvements could be made or where expectations are not fully met.
- **Poor Ratings:** There were no instances of “Poor” ratings, indicating that no significant concerns or critical issues were identified by the respondents.

Strengths: Criteria 2, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 10 received particularly high ratings, with most responses falling in the “Excellent” or “Good” categories. These areas represent strengths that the governing body can leverage to maintain its effectiveness.

Areas for Improvement: While the overall performance is positive, criteria 4, 5, 6, and 8 received some “Satisfactory” ratings, indicating areas where improvement efforts could be focused. Addressing these areas can further enhance the governing body's performance and effectiveness.

Recommendations: It is recommended that the governing body conducts further evaluation sessions to explore the areas identified for improvement.
