2<sup>nd</sup> technical Session: **Different shades of North Bengal region**

Total Seven Paper were presented by the participants from different colleges and university. The chairperson and the paper presenter in their discussion made an attempt to explore subjects from status of education system to the changing life pattern of the tribal people of the region.

3<sup>rd</sup> technical session: Women of North Bengal

Chairperson: Dr. Dahlia Bhattacharya, Associate Prof. Department of History, NBU.

Total Seven Paper were presented by the participants. The participants highlighted the issues and perspectives of women of the region. The session focused on subjects from history of movements and education of women to the socio-political dimension of Royal women.

Chairperson: Dr. Tanwir Arshed, Assistant Prof., Department of Political Science, Presidency University


Total Seven Paper were presented by the participant covering from women in social movement to their role in Self Help Group in North Bengal Region.
