

- 1. Professional Development Support: While 11.54% rated Excellent and 73.08% rated Good, indicating substantial satisfaction, 15.38% expressed room for improvement.
- 2. Scope for using Innovative Techniques and ICT: Responses varied, with 3.85% rating Excellent, 34.62% Good, 57.69% Satisfactory, and 3.85% indicating potential for further exploration.
- 3. Availability of Teaching Material: Similarly, 11.54% rated Excellent, 73.08% Good, and 15.38% Satisfactory, reflecting generally positive sentiments.
- 4. Workplace Environment: This criterion received notable acclaim, with 38.46% rating Excellent, 53.85% Good, and 7.69% Satisfactory, highlighting a conducive atmosphere.
- 5. Welfare Facilities provided by the Administration: While 69.23% rated Good, 30.77% Satisfactory, indicating overall satisfaction.
- 6. Inter-Personal Relationship among Co-Workers: Impressively, 42.31% rated Excellent, 57.69% Good, suggesting strong camaraderie.
- 7. Inter-Personal Relationship with the Head of Institution: 34.62% rated Excellent, 57.69% Good, with 7.69% indicating potential for enhancement.
- 8. Leadership Quality of the Head of Institution: Responses were varied, with 30.77% rating Excellent, 57.69% Good, 7.69% Satisfactory, and 3.85% indicating areas for improvement.
- 9. Basic Amenities provided for the Staff: While 11.54% rated Excellent, 65.38% Good, and 23.08% Satisfactory, reflecting a generally positive sentiment.
- 10. Overall Rating: Impressively, 11.54% rated Excellent, 76.92% Good, and 11.54% Satisfactory, highlighting overall satisfaction with the institution.
